**Using photography and storytelling as a public health tool**, Barren River District Health Department Health Information Branch is seeking a photojournalism intern to document the challenges, and rewards, of serving the community through the many facets of our public health mission.

### Essential Duties:

- Capture photographs or film video segments
- Conduct research to gather background information about a public health topic/event
- Conduct interviews to enhance and verify public health stories
- Use image-editing software such as Photoshop to edit images
- Submit images, text, and other information to health information staff
- Travel to assigned locations
- Explore relevant story concepts pertaining to public health
- Prepare drawings, illustrations, graphics, and other audiovisual material

### Desirable Skills:

- A good eye for capturing subjects on film
- Advanced design, editing, layout and graphics capabilities
- Ability to work independently
- Familiarity with Microsoft Office Suite (Outlook, Word, Excel, PowerPoint) and Adobe Creative Suite.
